> Regular Meeting Tuesday, March 14, 2022 (7 PM) Meeting Minutes

Present – Todd Pohlig, Richard Morsbach, Lloyd Spring, Doug Burnett, Kevin McCauley, John May, Bill Bohner (Engineer), Kristin Camp (Solicitor), and Don Curley (Administrator).

- 1. Call to Order The Chair called the meeting to order at 7 pm.
- 2. Minutes The EMA reviewed the minutes from the February 14, 2023 meeting. The Chair asked for public comment. No one from the public commented. The EMA approved the minutes (as submitted) by Unanimous Consent.

The EMA agreed to proceed with Item 4B and Item 7A:

- 4B (Wheeling Agreement) Kristin Camp, Don Curley, and Bill Bohner outlined key elements of a prospective wheeling agreement with Willistown Township. The EMA discussed it. John May made a motion to approve the agreement (as included in the meeting packet for the 3/14/23 meeting) with the addition of requirement that Willistown Township meter the flow into the EMA's system within 90 days of executing the agreement and reports the results to Easttown Township on an annual basis. Doug Burnett seconded the motion. The Chair asked for public comment. No one from the public commented. The Chair called the vote. The motion passed unanimously.
- 7A (Fund 63) Kristin Camp and Don Curley outlined key elements of the operation of Fund 63 (EMA Capital). The EMA discussed it. It (EMA) agreed by Unanimous Consent that the EMA is the lawful signatory of the fund, that the EMA's Solicitor should communicate this position to the Board of Supervisors (and the Township Solicitor), and that an EMA member (John May) should

represent this position to the BOS. The Chair asked for public comment. No one from the public commented. The Chair called the vote. The motion passed unanimously.

It (EMA) agreed by Unanimous Consent to approve the *LIST OF BILLS* (dated March 14, 2023) in the amount of \$4,339.52 from the Township's Sewer Fund (Fund 08), \$122.50 from the EMA Capital Fund (Fund 63), and \$10,345.53 from the capital bond fund (2020 Bond Funds). The Chair asked for public comment. No one from the public commented. The Chair called the vote. The motion passed unanimously.
