Tuesday June 15, 2021 (7 PM)
Meeting Minutes

The Meeting was held via an Authorized telecommunication device (GoToMeeting). Present – Tom Toscani (Chair), Margy DePiano (Vice Chair), Ted Babiy, Joan Stillwell, Stacey Ballard, Lisa Schwarcz, Kathryn Doms (EAC Liaison), Mike Wacey (Supervisor), and Don Curley (Public Works Director).

1. Call to Order – The Chair called the meeting to order at 7 PM.
2. Meeting Minutes
 - a. Consideration of Meeting Minutes from May 2021 Meeting – The PRB approved the minutes by unanimous consent (Public Comment was requested - no one from the public commented).
3. Business and Discussion Items
 - a. July 4th Event at Johnson Park – The PRB discussed the general description of the event (as specified in Don Curley's memo of 6/8/21). Public Comment was requested. No one from the public commented. The PRB approved (by unanimous consent) the description and recommended (by unanimous consent) to the BOS that the Township proceed with the event.
 - b. Planting in Courtyard – The PRB reviewed the plan that was submitted by the group of local volunteers (the Weeders) for replanting the courtyard. Public Comment was requested. Nancy Holmes (485 Beaumont Road) commented upon the value of the project. The PRB approved the plan by unanimous consent. Note that a copy of the plan is attached to these minutes.
 - c. Capital Projects Overview – The PRB reviewed the status of existing projects and the process of capital planning for the parks. No action was taken.
4. Old Business – The PRB discussed the planning-level details associated with the July 4th event at Johnson Park. No formal PRB action was taken.
5. Public Comment – No one from the public commented.
6. Announcements - The Chair announced the next Parks & Recreation Board meeting.
7. Adjournment – The meeting adjourned by unanimous consent at around 810 PM.
