Regular Meeting  
Tuesday August 17, 2021 (7 PM)  
Meeting Minutes

The Meeting was held at the Township Building and streamed via an authorized telecommunication device (GoToMeeting). Present – Tom Toscani (Chair), Margy DePiano (Vice Chair), Ted Babiy, Joan Stillwell, Stacey Ballard, Lisa Schwarcz, Kathryn Doms (EAC Liaison), Mike Wacey (Supervisor), and Don Curley (Public Works Director).

1. Call to Order – The Vice Chair called the meeting to order at 7 PM.
2. Meeting Minutes
  - a. Consideration of Meeting Minutes from the June 2021 Meeting – Stacey Ballard made a motion to approve the minutes. Margy DePiano seconded the motion. Public Comment was requested. No one from the public commented. The motion passed unanimously.
3. Business and Discussion Items
  - a. Courtyard Update – Don Curley updated the assembly on the status of the price solicitations that were issued for the planting. It was determined that an additional solicitation is required and that the Staff would attempt to get that solicitation.
  - b. 2022 Capital projects
    - 1) Basket Ball Court at Johnson Park – The PRB discussed the prospective renovation to the courts. No action was taken.
    - 2) Pickle Ball Courts – The PRB discussed the prospective installation of courts at the either Johnson Park or Hilltop Park. No action was taken.
    - 3) Courtyard Furnishings and Access - The PRB discussed the prospective installation of access routes and furnishings at Hilltop Park. No action was taken.
    - 4) Flag pole at Johnson Park - The PRB discussed the prospective installation of a flagpole at Johnson Park. No action was taken.
    - 5) Adjustable Nets and New Sand at Volley Ball Courts – No discussion occurred on this item.
    - 6) Path to Steam at Hilltop Park – Members of the Easttown Environmental Council (EAC) and the PRB discussed the prospective installation of a path(s) to the stream at Hilltop Park. No action was taken.
    - 7) Zip Lines and Shade Sails - The PRB discussed the prospective installation of a zip line and a shade sail at a park. No action was taken.

- c. Consideration of 2022 Programing – Members of the EAC, members of the Planning Commission, and the PRB discussed the prospective updating of the *1993 Recreation and Open Space Plan*. No action was taken. The PRB discussed 2022 programing including the continuation of the Easter egg hunt and the July 4<sup>th</sup> event and the prospective addition of a series of concerts or movies in the Park.
  - d. Consideration of Trex Bench in Hilltop Park – Members of the EAC indicated a desire to have a bench installed in the south-eastern corner of the park. The PRB unanimously supported the installation.
4. Old Business – No action was taken.
  5. Public Comment – No one from the public commented.
  6. Announcements - The Chair announced the next Parks & Recreation Board meeting.
  7. Adjournment – The meeting adjourned by unanimous consent at around 915 PM.
