- The following standard conditions shall apply to this Open Burning Permit upon issuance by the Township:
1. This permit may only be issued for the exceptions listed under Section 377-14..
 2. The open burning must be setback at least 50 feet from any building, structure or combustible materials.
 3. The open burning must be setback at least 25 feet from any public street or right-of-way.
 4. There must always be at least one responsible adult being 18 years or older attending the open burning until the fire is extinguished.
 5. It is the Applicant's responsibility to notify either Berwyn Fire Company and/or Paoli Fire Company prior to the event as appropriate to the location of the property on which the open burning is to occur, including Berwyn Fire Company and/or Paoli Fire Company.
 6. The time, location, and date approved in this permit for the burn must be strictly adhered to. Please notify and request permission from the Township prior to rescheduling.
